- is part of the ZBW – Leibniz Information Centre for Economics. The ZBW is the world's largest library for economics.
- forms part of the information network of the European Commission.
- was established by the European Commission to provide local access to EU publications for university staff and students as well as for the general public.

→ What you can find at the EDZ

The EDZ offers you ...

- Official journals
- Commission documents
- Eurostat statistics, e.g. economic and financial statistics, trade and industry statistics, agricultural and environmental statistics
- Publications by the European Central Bank
- Individual studies by the various Directorates General, such as the Directorate General for Economic and Financial Affairs, Directorate General for Research, Directorate General for Mobility and Transport, Directorate General for Agriculture and Rural Development
- Working papers of the European University Institute
- Reference sources and handbooks
