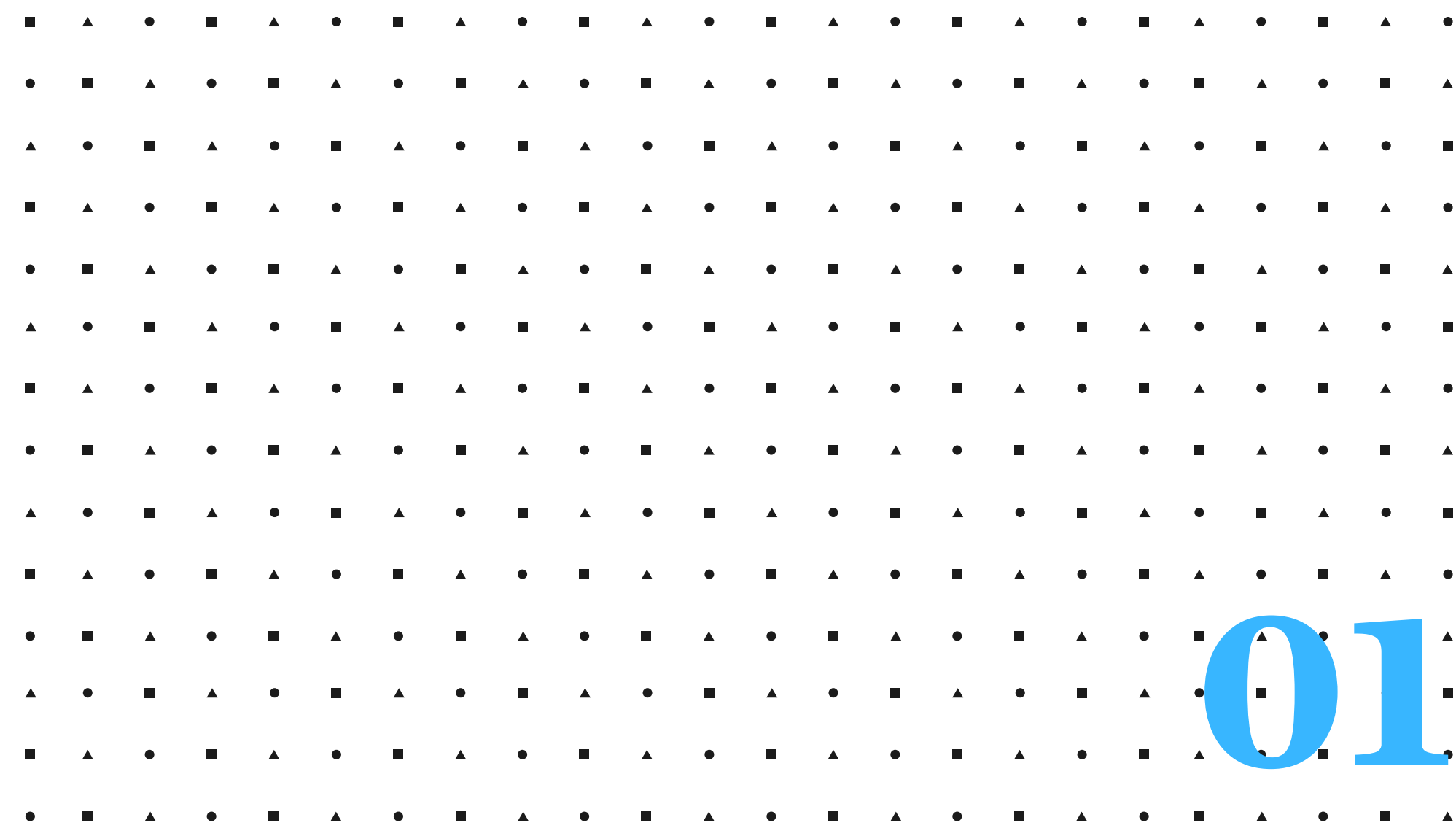

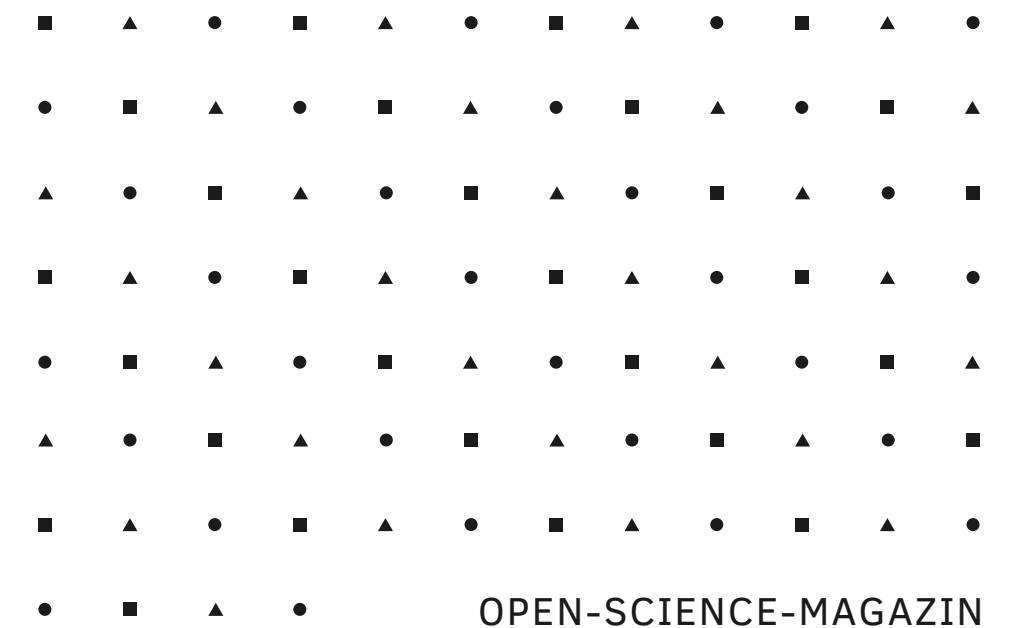

Content

Open Science experiences of researchers in economics and business

We regularly interview economists and business researchers from Germany, Austria and Switzerland about their specific experiences with Open Access, Open/FAIR data, Open Source, replication, pre-registration and scholarly communication. More than 60 interviews have now been published, and the range of benefits experienced from Open Science ranges from increased (inter)national visibility to very practical simplifications in daily work and competitive advantages in appointments.

Practical Open Science tips for everyday economists

The Practical Tips contain specific advice tailored to the discipline of economics and business research on a very specific topic, such as data management or open access publishing. There are also legal tips on licences, publication agreements and image rights.

Worksheets

The worksheets contain tasks that can be integrated into the daily routine of economic and business researchers. Depending on the topic, the task can take between 5 and 60 minutes to complete. In this way, researchers can become familiar with new platforms or applications at a low threshold.

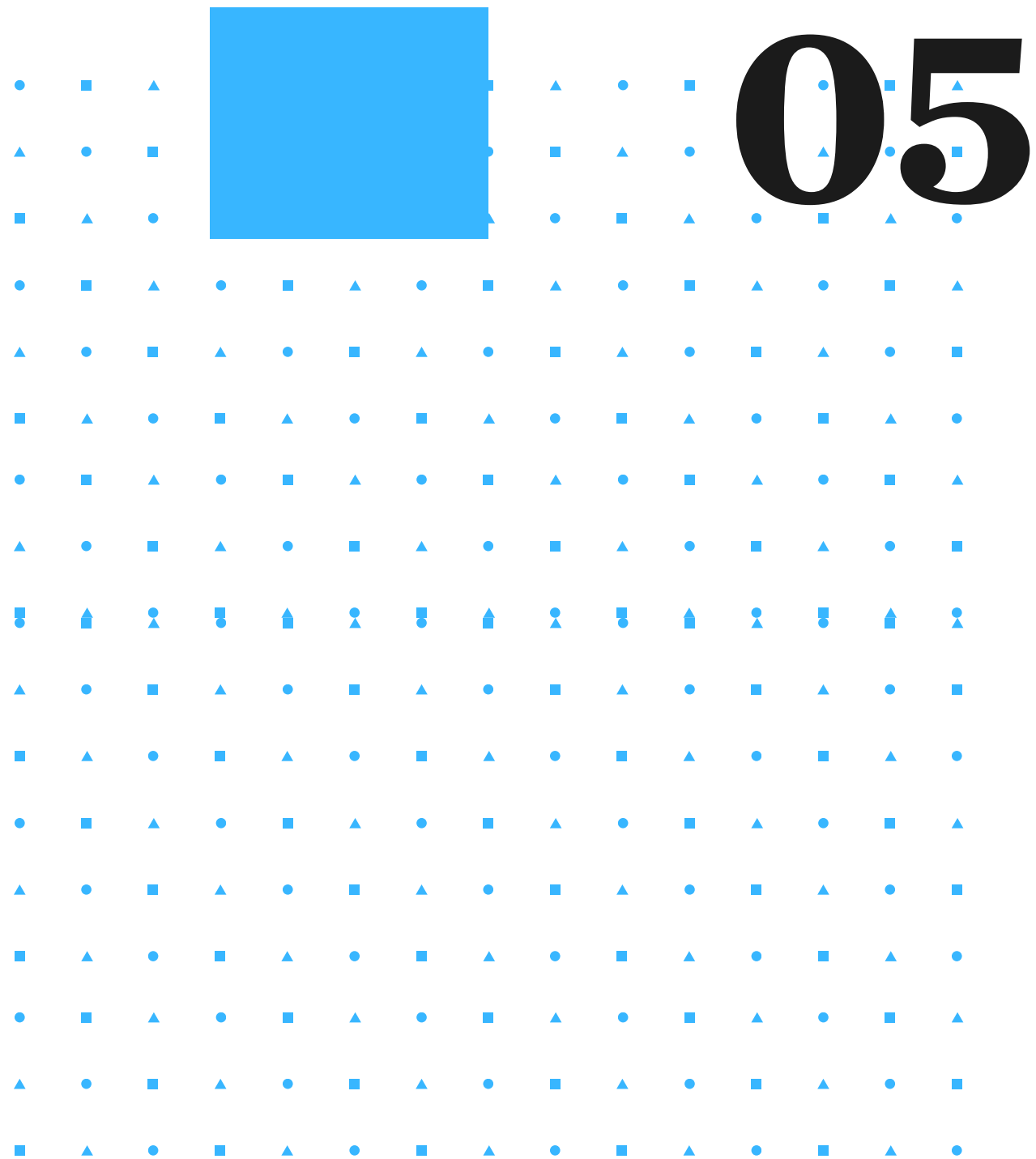

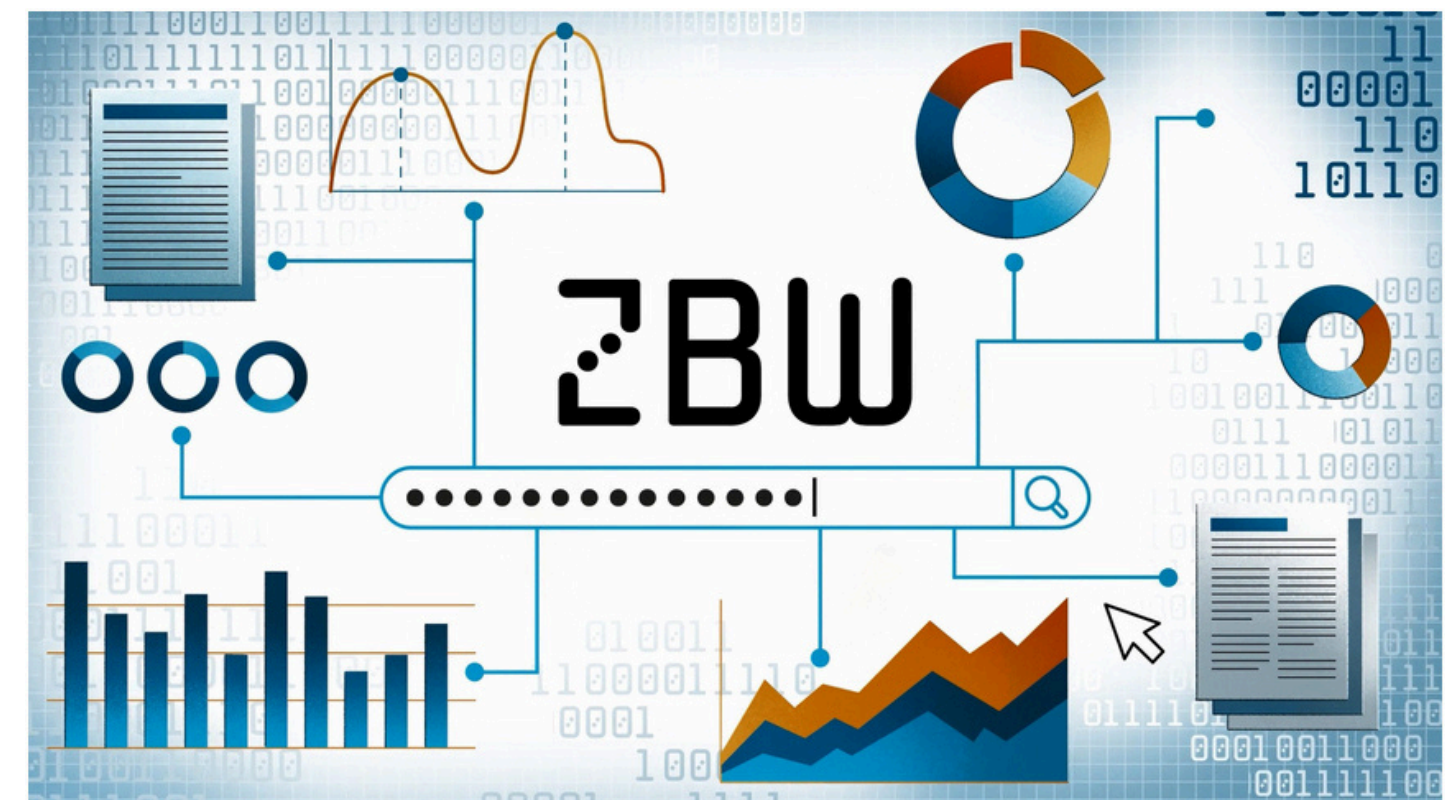
