## **EOSC EU Node**


# EOSC EU Node is the first European-level gateway of the EOSC Federation

## **EOSC EU Node – Services**

#### File Sync and Share

Enable automatic file syncing and secure sharing across locations and teams.

#### Virtual Machines

Design and conduct experiments with flexibility while ensuring reproducibility.

#### Interactive Notebooks

Create and share documents with realtime code execution.

#### **Cloud Container Platform**

Deploy cloud-native containerised applications that can easily scale.

#### Large File Transfer


Streamline large file transfers online with added security and integrity.

#### **Bulk Data Transfer**

Move data effortlessly to data-intensive execution environments



# Managed Services of the EU Node (1/2)














\* Not all managed services are depicted for simplicity reasons







# EOSC EU Node – Fair equitable Access to Services





## Credits

- Credits is the virtual 'currency' of the EOSC EU Node
  - Expresses the relative (and actual) cost of services but has no real monetary value
  - Users are already familiar with commercial offerings (pay as you go)
- A service has its cost expressed in credits
  - Clearly communicated to users, known in advance (how much will it cost?)
- A user is allocated free credits (wallet)
  - · Users can spend their credits according to their needs
  - Same amount of credits to all users of the same category, replenished every 3 months
- Credit economy evolves to support users and service providers





## **Access Policies**

- Authorizing users to access and spend their credits on the EOSC EU Node is an automated process based on their affiliation
- AP Level B
  - eduGAIN faculty (EU27 + Horizon Europe AC): 500 credits & access to all services
- AP Level A1
  - eduGAIN employee or staff (EU 27 + Horizon Europe AC) or EU Login staff: 100 credits & access
    to a subset of services
- AP Level A
  - View only access to the services





## **EOSC Federation**:

# Objectives of the build-up phase


- Testing and building interconnections of the essential federating capabilities (offered by the EOSC EU Node)
- Automated orchestration and deployment across autonomous service domains, federation of file sync & share, ...
- Exploring organisational arrangements, including those related to the implementation of policies shared across the Federation
- Estimating the costs, effort and time required to enrol a node and onboard a resource to the EOSC
- ...

# Federation Handbook – Why?

- Most Deliverables from EOSC projects are not "How To's"
- Goal to build the 1st Federation in 2025 is very ambitious



 Need a clear manual (+ guides) on how to build the Federation for Nodes to commit to joining the Federation

- 1. How to build the EOSC Federation during the period 2025 to 2027
- 2. What will the EOSC Federation enable and provide for researchers
- 3. How will the success of the EOSC Federation be measured

- Chapter 5 Scientific Resources

- Select and onboard of Candidate Nodes
